


- The court said the legislation 'goes further than necessary' to restrict rights

Chief Executive Carrie Lam said on Saturday that government will not drop an appeal over the anti-mask law, but said people should wear face masks in crowded place or if they are feeling unwell.

"But of course you can wear a face mask all the time, but you have to think about what's best for fighting the disease," she said.

Lam had enacted a ban on people wearing face masks at public events, invoking a colonial era emergency ordinance. But a judicial challenge by opposition lawmakers saw the court put the law in a limbo as it waits for a final decision.



When asked if the government would drop its appeal in wake of the new coronavirus outbreak, Lam said the appeal is not focused on the anti-mask law, but more on the power of the Chief Executive to enact laws during an emergency situation.



GCHQ has suggested that tech firms' communication services should be able to surreptitiously add intelligence agents to conversations or group chats

'Five Eyes' member countries have called for technology firms to help intelligence agencies by providing them with special, backdoor access to WhatsApp and other encrypted communications.

The group has also warned that failing to do so would put lives of thousands of people at risk.

"The Five Eyes are united that tech firms should not develop their systems and services, including end-to-end encryption, in ways that empower criminals or put vulnerable people at risk," British home secretary, Priti Patel, said at the conclusion of the two-day meeting of Five Eyes member countries in London.





- Worryingly, a day later, on 15 September, the Commissioner commissioned a paid advertising campaign on X (formerly Twitter) targeting the Netherlands, Sweden, Belgium, Finland, Slovenia, Portugal and the Czech Republic, countries that did not want to vote for the current proposal

X's Transparency Report shows that the European Commission also used 'microtargeting' to ensure that the ads did not appear to people who care about privacy (people interested in Julian Assange) and eurosceptics (people interested in 'nexit', 'brexit' and 'spanexit' or in Victor Orbán, Nigel Farage, or the German political party AfD).[17] For unclear reasons, people interested in Christianity were also excluded. After excluding critical political and religious groups, X's algorithm was set to find people in the remaining population who were indeed interested in the ad message, resulting in an uncritical echo chamber.
